


Overview

- Prague is the capital and the largest city in the Czech Republic and the historical capital of Bohemia.
- Prague is a political, cultural and economic center of central Europe complete with a rich history.
- Founded during the Romanesque and flourishing by the Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque eras and the main residence of several Holy Roman Emperors, most notably of Charles IV.
- The city played major roles in the Bohemian and Protestant Reformation, the Thirty Years' War and the history between the World Wars and the post-war Communist era.
- Prague is home to a number of well-known cultural attractions, many of which survived the violence and destruction of 20th-century Europe.
- Czech Republic is 04 Hours 30 Minutes behind of India Standard Time.
- 01 CZK = 03 INR







Culture

- The Czech nation possesses a distinctive culture. Their unique geographical position in the heart of Europe has invited influences from far and wide.
- The city of Prague (Praha) has always been a city of cultural, economic and political importance in the European continent.
- The historical city houses countless museums and art galleries where masterpieces from around the world are displayed.
- The people here are lovers of music and art and celebrate many traditional as well as music and dance festivals.
- Czech is the only official language of the Czech Republic, and it is spoken by about 96% of the population.
 Besides this, other languages can be heard here, particularly Slovak, German, Polish and Romany. English is spoken by limited people mainly from the tourism related jobs.
- Over the course of the centuries, Czech cuisine has been exposed to influences from its neighboring countries. Traditional Czech cuisine is distinguished by a large variety of dishes, and an impressive array of flavors. It also features the wide use of lean and fat-streaked pork, along with a rich choice of meals and side dishes prepared from flour. A most prominent dish made from flour is dumplings, a unique phenomenon of Czech cuisine.



Best Time to Visit

- The Best time to visit Prague is during Spring and early Fall.
- March, April and May are mild and many festivals happen during this period.
- June, July and August being the Summer Months are great for sightseeing, though this is the peak season for travelers.
- September and October being autumn another desirable period to visit Prague
- November, December, January and February being the Winter Months weather can be chilly.

Prague Castle



- Prague Castle is a castle complex in Prague, built in 9th Century.
- The complex is the official office of the President of the Czech Republic.
- The castle was a seat of power for kings of Bohemia, Holy Roman emperors, and presidents of Czechoslovakia.
- According to the Guinness Book of Records, Prague Castle is the largest ancient castle in the world.
- There are some popular tourist sites of Prague within the castle walls including St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George's Basilica, the Powder Tower, the Old Royal Palace, and the Golden Lane.
- Opening Hours:
 - Prague Castle complex:- 6:00Hrs 22:00Hrs
 - Historical buildings:- 9:00Hrs 17:00Hrs
 - In winters it closes by 16:00Hrs
- The best way to fully explore the castle is on a 2 Hours 30 Mins Prague Castle Walking Tour with a guide dispensing interesting historical anecdotes, visit gargantuan gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George's Basilica Golden Lane and much more.





St. Vitus Cathedral



- Situated within the grounds of Prague Castle, the Roman Catholic St. Vitus Cathedral is the Czech Republic's largest and most important Christian church.
- Seat of the Archbishop of Prague, it's also home to the tombs of numerous saints and three Bohemian kings.
- Opening Hours:
 - Monday to Saturday: 9:00Hrs 17:00Hrs
 - Sunday: 12:00Hrs 17:00

Charles Bridge



- Charles Bridge is the historic bridge that crosses the Vltava river.
- Its construction started in 1357 under the auspices of King Charles IV, and finished in the beginning of the 15th century.
- This new bridge was originally called Stone Bridge or Prague Bridge but has been "Charles Bridge" since 1870.
- As the only means of crossing the river Vltava until 1841, Charles Bridge was the most important connection between Prague Castle and the city's Old Town and adjacent areas.



Wenceslas Square



- A highlight of Prague's New Town district, an area that grew out of the city's need to expand as it prospered, is the wonderful Wenceslas Square and homes the National Museum and numerous other architectural treasures.
- Wenceslas Square was created in the 14th century during the reign of Charles IV as a horse market and has since become one of the city's most important public spaces, still used for demonstrations and celebrations alike.
- It's also the site of the city's largest Christmas Market in December.

The National Museum



- Fresh from a seven-year-long renovation, the National Museum in Prague is spread across a number of locations and houses numerous important collections representing a variety of fields, with literally millions of items covering mineralogy, zoology, anthropology, and archaeology, as well as the arts and music.
- The oldest museum in the Czech Republic, it was established in the early 1800s before moving to its current location in 1891.
- A particularly enjoyable highlight is the archaeology exhibit with its extensive collection of 1st-and 2nd-century Roman artifacts, along with numerous Bronze and Early Iron age finds.



The Old Town Square - City Centre



- Old Town Square is an historic square in the old town quarter of Prague.
- It is located between Wenceslas Square and Charles Bridge.
- The square features buildings belonging to various architectural styles, churches from the 14th Century, Palaces, Gothic Doorway the medieval astronomical clock tower and National Gallery Art Museum.
- The square's center is home to a statue of religious reformer Jan Hus, who was burned at the stake for his beliefs in Constance.

Prague Orloj or The Astronomical Clock



- Prague Orloj is a medieval astronomical clock mounted on the Old Town Hall.
- The clock mechanism has three main components the astronomical dial, representing the position of the Sun and Moon in the sky and displaying various astronomical details.
- Each hour, it springs to life as the 12 Apostles and other figures appear and parade in procession across the clock face.



The Clementinum and the National Library



- The Clementinum, one of the largest collections of historic buildings in Europe, is home to the National Library of the Czech Republic, housing more than six million books, includes copies of every book published in the Czech Republic.
- These buildings were originally part of a Jesuit College, and later become the Jesuit book collection, and Karolinum book collection.
- The library eventually became the property of the state after the Jesuits were expelled, and the Clementinum became a public library in 1782 shortly after being constituted as the National Library.

The Strahov Monastery and Library



- The Strahov Monastery and Library dates back to the 12th century and is the second oldest monastery in Prague, housing churches and 02 Baroque libraries - Philosophical & Theological.
- The Philosophical Library contains a variety of extraordinary furnishings, along with an exquisite ceiling painted by Franz Anton Maulbertsch entitled Enlightenment.
- The second library, the Theological Library, consists of a splendid Baroque room with a beautiful ornate painted ceiling, along with superb ceiling frescoes framed and many rare old volumes and manuscripts such as 9th-century Strahov Gospel.







Vltava River Cruise

Karlovy Vary



- Karlovy Vary is a spa town situated in western Bohemia, on the confluence of the rivers Ohře and Teplá, approximately 130 km
 2 Hours west of Prague. The city has approximately 48,500 inhabitants.
- It is named after Charles IV, Holy Roman Emperor and King of Bohemia, who founded the city in 1370.
- Things to do/see:
 - Numerous hot springs (13 main springs, about 300 smaller springs, and the warm-water Teplá River)
 - Moser Glass Factory
 - some of Karlovy's legendary herbal liqueur.







Cesky Krumlov




- Cesky Krumlov is a city in the South Bohemia region bisected by the Vltava River, approximate 170 kms - 2 Hours south of Prague and dominated by its 13th-century castle (UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1992). The city has approximately 13,100 inhabitants.
- The core of the old town is within a horseshoe bend of the river, with the old Latrán neighborhood and castle on the other side of the Vltava.
- Things to do/see:
 - Cesky Krumlov Castle
 - Architecture from 14th to 17th Century with Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque styles
- Cesky Krumlov hosts a number of festivals and other events each year.

- Don Giovanni Hotel Prague is a 4-star hotel located in Prague's popular residential area of "Vinohrady" in close proximity to the city centre.

- Distance from Airport: 25 Kms / 40 Min








Hilton Prague

Visa Requirement

Visa Notes & Fees

- 1. Passport: Original Passport with validity of minimum three months (from the date of return) and minimum two blank pages (Back to back) for visa stamp. Please note
 - a) Passports issued beyond 10 years will not be accepted by the Embassy
 - b) Handwritten passports will not be accepted.
 - c) Attach all your old passports (if any)
- 2. Schengen Visa Application Form: One visa application form back to back, duly filled and signed. Refer to Signatures on Czech Visa Application Form Please note: Applicant mobile number should be mentioned in visa form as Embassy / Consulate can contact the applicant at any point of time during visa processing
- 3. Photo Specification: Two recent passport size colored photographs with matt or semi matt finish, 60%-80% face coverage, white background and without border (Size: 35mm x 45mm)
 - Please note: Photograph should not be more than 3 months old, scanned/stapled and should not be used in any of the previous visas.
- 4. Covering-Letter: Covering Letter from applicant on business letter head mentioning name, designation, passport number, purpose and duration of visit in brief. The letter should be duly signed by authorized signatory with company stamp and addressed to The Visa Officer, Embassy of the Czech Republic, New Delhi
 - Please Note: Covering Letter on Letterhead if applicant is Self Employed or on plain paper if Employed.
- 5. Airline Reservation: Ticket Itinerary
- 6. Proof of Accommodation : Hotel confirmation for the entire period of stay as per the tour itinerary. Please Note: Hotel should match the ticket dates and maximum stay should be in Czech Republic
- 7. Medical: Travel medical insurance valid for all Schengen-countries. The insurance has to cover the applicant for at least 30,000 Euros or equivalent, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency evacuation etc. The policy has to clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the entire duration of the trip including the date of arrival and departure.
- 8. Financials:
 - a) Company's and Personal ITR.
 - b) Six months salary slip.
 - c) Original Personal bank account statement (proof of sufficient financial means) of last three months with Original Seal and Sign from Bank. If someone is sponsoring the Trip then a affidavit is required for sponsorship along with his Bank Statement and National ID Proof Copy which has signature in it. E.G.- PAN Card, Note: Bank statement should be on A4 size paper.
 - d) Credit Card copy/Foreign Exchange endorsement/Traveler's Cheque

- 9. Proof of Occupation Self Employed
 - a) Company Registration Certificate / Certificate of Incorporation.
 - b) Brief Company Profile.
 - c) Articles of Memorandum (Incase the applicant is MD/Director).
 - d) Proof of Proprietorship / Partnership (In case applicant is Proprietor / Partner in a firm).
 - e) Import / Export License (if applicable).

Employed

a) Proof of employment like Salary Slip or Appointment Letter / NOC from Employer.

Student

- a) Leave Sanction Letter from school
- b) Parents have to provide ITR, Bank statement and NOC letter
- 10. Authorization Letter: Applicant will have to submit an authorization letter authorizing Udaan India Private Limited to submit documents.
- 11. Passport Collection Process, Embassy has announced that representatives cannot collect the documents on behalf of applicant from Czech Republic

 15. Visa Application Centres except in following conditions:
 - a) Immediate family member (that is Parents, Children, Spouse)
 - b) One member of a family group collecting the passports of the whole family.
 - c) A person collecting on behalf of Government officials if authorized on the Government letter head or department.

If any of the above comes for passport collection they need to carry the following documents:

- a) Original Government ID card
 - b) Original ICR
 - c) Original authorization letter from applicant
- 12. However, applicants who do not wish to collect their documents in person & whose documents cannot be collected by one of the above, will get their passports back by courier at an additional cost of Rs. 300/- to the dispatch address mentioned in the courier form & Covering Letter which has to be submitted along with the visa application.
- 13. Please Note:
 - a) Prior Appointment is mandatory.
 - b) If applying for Multiple Entry Czech Affidavit Form is required on Company's letter head.
- 4. Processing Time: Processing time for short term Czech Republic visa application is 10 working days. Please note that this is an indicative processing time only. Processing time may increase or decrease at the discretion of the Embassy of Czech Republic. Further to that, applications with the date of departure earlier than 8 calendar days (including Saturday and Sunday) after the date of submission will not be accepted.
- 15. New Procedure for Schengen Visa Applications: With immediate effect, Indian citizens travelling to Schengen countries for short-term (max 90 days in 180 days) will have to visit VFS visa application centre personally to provide biometric data (fingerprints and digital photograph). For subsequent applications within next 5 years the biometric data will be copied from the previous visa application included in the VIS.
